AHA has three books on Classic beer styles now available. The styles are Lambic(Brand New), Continental Pilsner(European Pilsners) and Foster's Pale Ale. Each is \$9.95 to members and \$11.95 to non-members (Lambic is \$8.45 mem and \$10.15 non-mem if ordered before 12/31/90).

I will maintain a file of information from the AHA (and will try to bring it to every meeting), so anyone interested in what they have to offer to homebrewers can contact me by mail, phone or at a meeting.

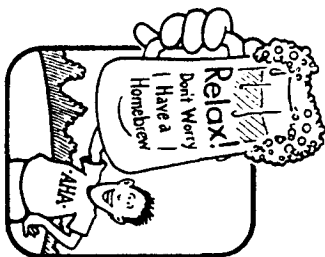
