November Meeting Road Trip

The November meeting will be held at the Lakefront Brewery. The meeting will be held on the 3rd Wednesday of the month, one week earlier than usual, on November 15th, at 7:30 PM.

Lakefront Brewery is located at 1872 N. Commerce Street, Milwaukee WI.

Commerce Street is located just West of the Milwaukee River a short distance North of Downtown Milwaukee.

There are a couple of ways to get there from downtown. From the Bradley Center area, head North on 3rd St under the Freeway. Proceed about 4 blocks until you get to the intersection with Walnut St on the west and

Pleasant St on the east. Turn right on Pleasant and head east for about 3 blocks. Commerce Street is the last street before you approach the bridge over the River. Turn left on Commerce and head north a couple of blocks.

If you are coming from the Water St area head north under the Freeway. Continue on Water past Laacke & Joys until you get to Pleasant Street. Turn left on Pleasant and take the bridge over the river. Commerce St is the first street on the right after the bridge.

Milwaukee Area Homebrew Shops

A key ingredient in Home Brewing is the ability to pick up supplies to make a batch of beer. Your best source of supplies is your local Homebrew shop. When you need something today to brew a batch, there is nowhere else to get it. If we don't support these establishments, they may not be there when we need them.

There are times when it can be tempting to order from a catalog or off the internet, but before you send your money far away, check to see if your local shop has what you want. If they don't carry something that you want, try asking them if they could get it for you. Sometimes the only reason that they don't have something on hand is that they don't know if it will sell. Most shop owners are willing to order something for you, and often at a price comparable to mail order sources if you add in the shipping costs.

There are at least seven homebrew shops in the Milwaukee area. This winter why not visit them all and see what each one has to offer.
