The saison was brewed on Spike's 50 gallon pilot system in their test brewery, and they allowed us to utilize 3 of their conical fermenters to experiment with different yeast strains. There were also some carboys that went home with members for further yeast experimentation. The resulting beer will then be served at the World of Beer Festival, where Spike will be set up next to the Barons on the Homebrew Patio. Stop by and check out the results, as well as ask which yeasts were used for which ones. The carboys will be brought to a future meeting on Saisons to further dissect the results.
