Treasurer Report

Happy Brewing Barons. As of 4/30/19, our Club bank balance was \$7,025. The club just paid for tickets for 2 larger expenses (Chilton & Taste of Midwest), and those debits are reflected in the \$7,025 balance. The Club bank balance one year ago (on 4/30/19) was \$6,686. Attendance for the April General meeting was 81 individuals, and we collected \$215 in meeting and membership fees that night.

I hope everyone enjoyed the April general meeting in which Lance Shaner, the owner and founder of Omega Yeast, spoke about one of the main ingredients in beer – yeast. Hopefully, you learned something, or at least were entertained with the presentation. Kudos to Tom Nowalis for organizing the educational content for general meetings thus far in 2019. This month, Gathering Place, a commercial brewery will be coming to our meeting to tell us more about themselves.

Please be aware that we had some faucets on our jockey box that were leaking and couldn't close correctly anymore, so we decided to replace them. We spent \$241 on new faucets and shanks.


