Treasurer Report

Happy Brewing Barons. As of 6/30/19, our Club bank balance was \$6,492. The Club bank balance one year ago (on 6/30/18) was \$8,903. We do have a larger expense coming up to pay for the club's insurance, which will likely be paid in August. I just supplied a current roster to the insurance company, and it shows that we currently have 145 members.

Attendance for the June General meeting (Chocolate Pairing Meeting) was 89 individuals, which was the 2nd highest attended meeting this year. We had 13 guests attend this meeting, which was the most this year. Seems like we know a lot of people who like chocolate (and beer).
