Membership Renewal Process


Just a reminder that current memberships expire 1/31/20

Treasurer Report

Happy Brewing Barons. As of 12/31/19, our Club bank balance was \$9,841.02, but this does not include 3 larger expenses for the Christmas party. Those 3 expenses are: 1) \$1,447.05 check to Cliffords for food and hall rental, 2) \$126.11 check for beer, & 3) \$1,200 (approximate) for raffle prizes and take-home beer. Considering these expenses, the club balance is actually closer to \$7,068. The Club bank balance one year ago (on 12/31/18) was \$6,580.36.

We had 110 individuals attend the December general meeting (Christmas Party), including 16 guests, and we collected \$1,640 in raffle money. When comparing to 2018's Christmas Party, we had 120 individuals attend and collected \$1,645 in raffle money.

Our current membership is 166, but remember your 2019 membership ends on 1/31/19. Thus, it is time to renew. PayPal is an option and may be easier for you in that you don't have to wait in a potentially long line at the sign-in desk at the next meeting. Please check the club website to pay through PayPal and for membership options. Please note that the cost for membership is the same for 2020 as it was in 2019.



January - Did You Know???



Although I have not gone through the Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP) yet, I regularly consult the 93 page, 2015 BJCP Style Guidelines. This is especially helpful when attempting to make a beer according to style, and entering it into a homebrew competition, such as the approaching Midwinter Homebrew Competition (entry deadline is 1/25/20). There are 34 separate categories in the 2015 BJCP Style Guidelines.

Match the 2015 BJCP sub-category (Beer Style) with the appropriate 2015 BJCP category it belongs to. For example, the sub-category Kolsch (5B) belongs to the category Pale Bitter European Beer (Category 5).

- One Kellerbier entry (BJCP category 7C) will be chosen to be ramped up by the Milwaukee Brewing Company for serving at the Milwaukee Ale House.
- One Mead entry (BJCP categories M1, M2, M3, M4B, and M4C) will be chosen by Moonlight Meadery to qualify for their Pro Am Competition.
- White Winter Winery will choose one cider entry (BJCP categories C1 & C2) to be made at their winery

New for 2020

*Friday evening, there will be a beer and food pairing event open to the public from 7:00 – 9:00. There will be 4 breweries pouring 3 beers each (12 total beers). Each beer will have food paired specifically for it. This will be a walk around sample type event where you can try what you want, go back for what you like. Cost will likely be in \$45-55 range, but volunteers who work at least 5 sessions get free access and those who work at least 3 sessions will get half off. Beers will be high end, often seasonal or hard to get beers. Details are being finalized and will be available shortly.

*Sessions reduced to 1.5 hours with mini-BOS's judged in parallel. Flight size per session will be held to around 6. This allows us to be done early enough for the Friday night event. On Saturday we will have 2 sessions in the morning with a 3rd after lunch. Category judging of 3 sessions will be done about 2:30, and BOS's by 4:00.

There will not be an awards ceremony.

*This year Midwinter HBC is part of the National Meadmaker of the Year circuit. This has increased the number of mead entries, so if you are a mead judge you will have more opportunity to judge meads


