Important Things to Know For Attending the Meeting In Person

Upon arrival, you will have your temperature taken and will be asked to sign the waiver below that specifies the expectations and precautions we are taking to keep our members safe.

If you are unable or unwilling to meet the expectations, please join us remotely.

Beer Barons Event Waiver

Things you should know before attending this Beer Barons of Milwaukee event.

The venue, Clifford's Supper Club in Hales Corners, WI has relocated tables to account for social distancing and are using commercial grade cleaners that kill viruses such as COVID 19.

• We ask that you leave tables in their current locations and do not move them, orange cones will be used as reminders to socially distance.

We the Beer Barons of Milwaukee have added the following measures to keep you and others attending as safe as possible.

- All attendees will be asked to enter through the banquet hall entrance (located on the West side of the building).
- Upon entering your temperature will be taken and recorded on this waiver.
- The following PPE will be provided for your use: Face Masks, Nitrile Gloves, Disinfectant Wipes, Hand Sanitizer and Sanitized one-time-use pens.
- Disposable cups will be used for each pour at the Jockey Boxes. Jockey Boxes will be separated to encourage social distancing.
- Beverages on the Jockey Boxes will no longer be self-serve; a bartender/server will be present and will serve you at each Jockey Box.
- Face Shields will be made available for all staff/volunteers.

By signing this Waiver, you agree not to hold the Beer Barons of Milwaukee responsible if your contract COVID19 or any other communicable disease. You also confirm that you do not have COVID19, are not ill and have not been in contact with someone who has COVID19.

*If you participate in bottle shares you do so at your own risk.





Step 2: check your email for the registration email and click the blue button to active your account.







Treasurer Report

Happy Brewing Barons. Our club bank balance is \$10,269.59, as of 7/31/20. Our biggest expense in July was insurance for the club. We paid \$855 for General Liability and Directors & Officers insurance to the West Insurance Agency (aka for the AHA Insurance). The cost is based on how many members we had at that point in time, which was 119 members. The effective date of the insurance is from 9/01/20 - 8/31/21.

Hope you had a chance to attend the 7/22/20 general meeting, in which Ryan Hammerel from East Troy Brewery was in person to talk about his brewery that he started in 2018. This was the first physical general meeting we had as a club since the 2/26/20 general meeting. It was also a virtual meeting if you chose to join through Zoom. In terms of attendance for the 7/22/20 general meeting, there were 21 individuals who physically attended (17 Gold members & 4 Regular members). There were approximately 20 individuals that joined us virtually.

I was sad when I looked at my family calendar on my refrigerator and saw an entry on 8/08/20 that had a line struck through it that said, "Great Taste of the Midwest". As you know, it was canceled this year due to the pandemic. If you have never been to this one before (held in Madison), this is one you should check out. The club sells a limited supply of tickets and a bus trip to this event every year. Keep an eye out for it next year. The only beer event that is better is of course our very own – "World of Beer Fest", also known as WOB.

In terms of membership, we currently have 123 members.

The majority of the Board will be turning over at the end of this year, including the position I hold – the highly regarded Treasurer position. If you have an interest in this position (and even if you don't), seek me out so we can discuss, or consider attending a board meeting to see what it is we do. Being on the board is a very good way to learn all the inner workings of our club, and you get a voice regarding how our club spends your hard-earned membership dues. The Treasurer gets the privilege of checking everyone in at the general meetings, and gets to see everybody's smiling faces. When I first started as the Treasurer in January 2019, I made it a goal to attempt to learn everyone's name, so when they checked in, I could greet them with a personalized hello. For the last 5 general meetings of 2020, test me to see if I remember your name, but keep in mind we do have 123 members, and I am still learning.

Did You Know???

At our last board meeting, we were discussing how Robert Hansen, one of our Members-at-Large on our club's Board, discovered our great homebrew club. Robert indicated that he found out through the AHA (American Homebrew Association). That made me wonder how many homebrew clubs there were in Milwaukee, in Wisconsin, and in the country. First off, the venue has changed since the parks department has had to pull back on the quantity of open parks due to the reduction in staff. This year we will be at the

#5 Pavilion at Greenfield Park in West Allis.

The area is very similar to Root River, so we will have space for tents, chairs, yard games and the like.

That being said, if you wish to bring a dish to have at your table, please feel free to do so. Anyone who wishes to share in that dish does so at their own risk.

However, we WILL still have the Jerry Hetzel Memorial competition! Please plan on bringing some of your delicious fermented beverages to share! That being said, the jockey boxes will be set up a bit different – we will have a 'bartender' serving the samples in plastic cups to limit the number of people touching the taps.
