From Sgt. John:

From time to time, various members borrow our serving equipment for events they are attending. Most of the time, I'm available to either drop off or attend in person. When I'm not part of the event, other members need to be responsible for the equipment. This is not unusual and has not been an issue the great majority of the time.

The Barons exhibited at the annual Food & Froth at the museum a couple of weeks ago. This was an event I did not attend in person. As of this writing (April 8), I still do not have all the equipment back. The jockey box covers and our 2 black utility buckets are still out, and we have two events coming up before the next general meeting.

Of greater concern is the condition of the large gas tank. It must have been dropped or fallen because the handle and stem are damaged. I normally get things back in a timely fashion, and in good condition. If you are responsible for our equipment, it is your duty to get all of it back on time and in the same condition you got it in other words, fix it before returning it or tell someone on the board so it can get fixed in a timely manner **before** it is needed again.
